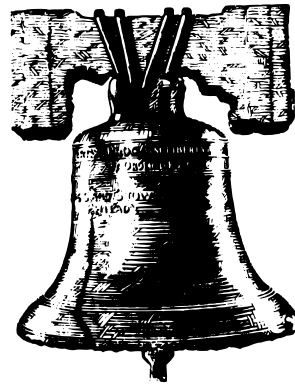

## Grand Knight Report July 2016

This came to me from a Brother Knight. Who I won't name, but it really hit home, so I wanted to share it with you. Let Unite with this Knight and support his mission of Charity.

Today I celebrate Father's Day with a heavy heart. The first day of my Charity "A Cry For Help", I went around town talking to our homeless people and giving them bottle water. (Manatee County has over 300 homeless people.) It's sad that we as a county can give money for war and to build or rebuild other Country's but what about the people here at home? We have hundreds if not thousands of people homeless here in America. Many have lost their hope and pride in our Country. Many have mental and physical disability's Then what does our Country do to help them? Nothing! They live and sleep in our street. To get a shower and get a good night sleep they must pay \$10.00 a night per person at the Salvation Army. Those with pets are turned away. They can't panhandle or beg for money because it is illegal, they can get arrested and put in jail for it. (Some may say "at least they have food and a place to stay" but really??? At the cost of their freedom and a criminal record?) If they patch a tent in an open field, on or near an abandoned building or a lot it's trespassing. The One Stop Center (Our Daily Bread) one meal a day, seven days a week but lack of transportation and limitations some can't even to make it eat.

I have been homeless before, I feel their pain, lack of trust and loss of hope. I ask Please the next time you see a homeless person or family don't judge "help". Give them some food or bottle water, a blanket or a sheet, a coat, or a jacket. Remember help doesn't have to be monetary but what your heart can give. Please pray for the homeless, the persecuted, those who believe and those who don't believe.
