I would like to thank all the Knights and Ladies of St. Joseph that came out to paint and refurbishment of the Fr. McLaughlin Hall on Saturday, February 11. This was more than one day of doing. Tables and chairs and pictures were moved after our February meeting. All windows blinds were removed and replaced with new wooden brown blinds, walls were painted lite beige with one accent wall painted blue to match the chairs and council flag, inside doors painted dark brown. Outside leaves raked up and the hall pressure washed. Over 100 volunteer hours was put into this project.
